US CONGRESSMAN RUSS FULCHER (R-IDAHO) ENDORSES TRACEY KOELLISCH FOR IDAHO HOUSE – DISTRICT 14A

Eagle, Idaho, (March 8, 2022) – US Congressman Russ Fulcher has announced his endorsement of Tracey Koellisch for Idaho House District 14A. "I am deeply honored to receive Russ' endorsement," said Tracey Koellisch. "Russ has been leading the fight to protect Idahoans from federal overreach and to stop Democrats from their reckless spending and policies that include trying to federalize the United States election system. Russ understands we need people of deep resolve and fortitude to combat the progressive agenda making its way into Idaho. His support is a strong indicator of his confidence I will fight to preserve our Constitutional values and individual liberties while representing District 14." Koellisch said.

The Idaho Commission on Reapportionment finalized its legislative redistricting plan on November 10, 2021. The new legislative district map will now have an open seat in District 14A, currently held by House Majority Leader Mike Moyle – R. Moyle will now run in District 10 as a result of the new redistricting plan.

Koellisch has also received endorsements from Eagle Mayor, Jason Pierce, Eagle Council Pro tem, Brad Pike, and Councilwomen Melissa Gindlesperger and Helen Russell. Additionally, she has also received the endorsement from former Eagle Mayor, Nancy Merrill.

Koellisch announced her candidacy for State Representative District 14A on February 6, 2022. She currently serves as the Ada County Republican State Committeewoman and has served as an elected Precinct Committeewoman since 2016. She is a current member of the Executive Board with the Ada County Republicans and sits on the Idaho Republican Party State Central Committee. Koellisch also served as a Delegate for President Donald J. Trump at the 2020 Republican National Convention.
